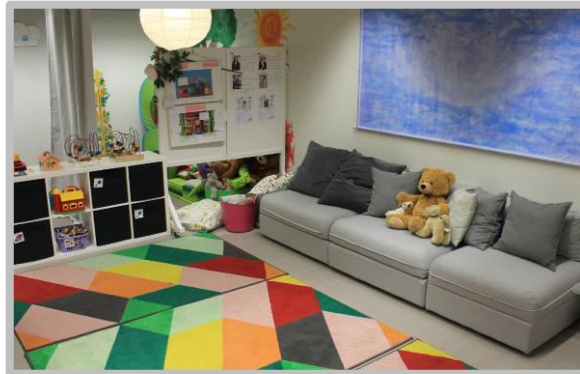


Welcome to Kuopion Perheentalo!

At Kuopion Perheentalo you can:



- meet families, gain new friends

- feed and take care of your baby



The kitchen with its necessities (the microwave, the dishes, the highchairs etc.) are free for use for the families.

The instructors and volunteers of Perheentalo are available to help for example with dressing a child. They can keep your child company for a brief moment so you can have a cup of coffee. The instructors will be present during activities, but the main responsibility for the children lies with the parents.
